## **Yearly Meeting**

## **Entrance system**

The system is now online and fob tags have been collected by almost everyone. The locks on several brf doors will be changed to increase security. ## **Laundry room**

From 19th September you will need an fob tag to access the laundry room.

As some might have noticed the laundry room is now locked to be used 2 time per 30 days. The brf rules for usage of the laundry room is 2 time per month, if you need to wash more often, do it at home.

## **Internet booking of laundry room**

Internetbooking is not online, to be able to book online you must first go down to the booking display and put on your tag. Then you fill out email and password under "inställningar". Complete guide on how you do this is on our website under "vanliga frågor" and "tvättstuga"

## **The change to Bahnhof**

Routers have now be given out to almost all members and the internet service is online. From what we can see the switch has worked very well. We just want to remind everyone that has switched to not forget to cancel your Comhem (tele2) subscription, even if you only have the previously free internet. After 31st October it will start costing 439 kr per month unless you have cancelled it. If you have a faster broadband from tele2 it will become 300 kr more expensive per month. Do not throw away your old tele2 modem, tele2 probably wants it back.

If you for some reason want to keep using another internet service provider you can of course do this, but you have to pay for the full cost of the isp yourself. Regardless if you want to use Bahnhof or not it is delivered to the internet outlet in your electrical cabinet.

## **Wrong address choice on activation**

Several members have chosen the wrong address when they activated their new internet, it will be corrected continuously to Bahnhof. If you chose the wrong address it's possible you will have to re-activate it when this is corrected.
